Dick then welded as much of the sculpture together as possible indoors. Because it's 25 feet long, 14 feet wide and seven feet tall, the sculpture had to be moved outside for final welding.

"People kid me about it," admits John. "They call it Beaton's jungle gym."

In a similar vein, Dick is hearing himself referred to as the "da Vinci of the Sheet Metal Shop."

"The whole project was challenging and a lot of fun," says Dick, a 13-year shop veteran. "It's the first sculpture I've ever made."
